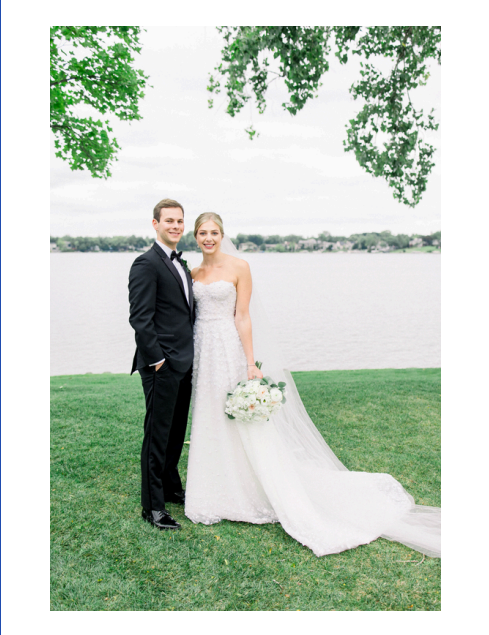

# HFRS WEDDINGS AND UPDATES



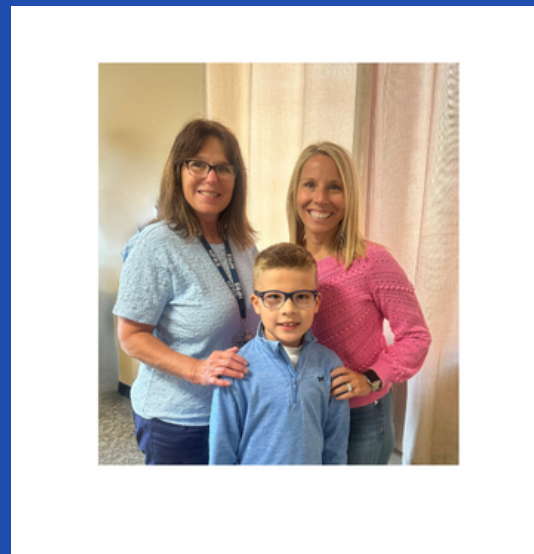

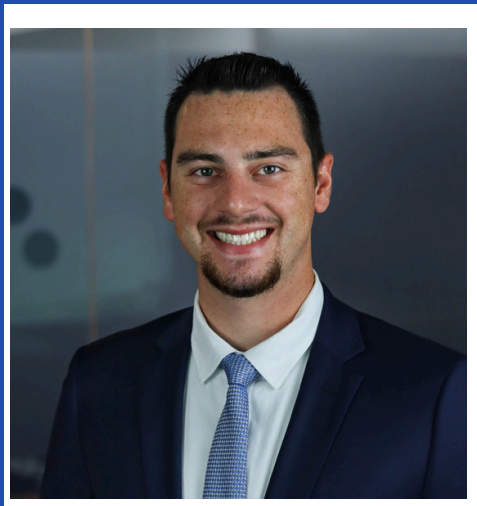
# HFRS ANNOUNCEMENTS

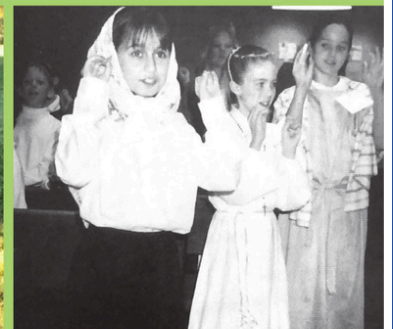
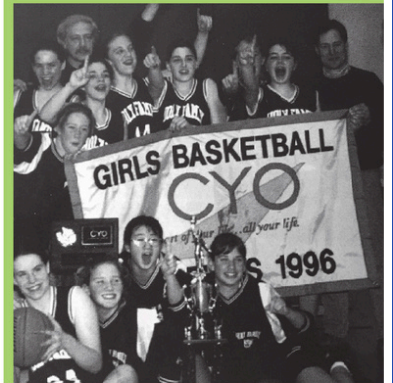
